

# (ABE) ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (GED PREP) PROGRAM 607.5-HOUR PROGRAM / 18Weeks

This program is designed to prepare the student to sit for and pass the GED Exam (General Education Development). The GED Test reflects the major outcomes normally acquired in a four-year high school program. The course is designed to facilitate the student in passing the test and provide the necessary background information on key concepts in the five subject areas of: Language Arts, Writing Skills, Language Arts, Reading Skills, Social Studies, Science and Mathematics. The program will provide students with plenty of practice, pretests, hands-on training, and extensive exercises in each instructional section, posttests and practice exams in all areas.
